

About the Assessment Workbook

The RJC Assessment Workbook can assist Members conduct a Self Assessment and prepare for the independent audits.

The Workbook is likely to be most useful for:

- Members preparing for a Self Assessment,
- Identifying and documenting the Certification Scope
- Documenting Provenance Claims
- Implementing corrective actions to meet the Code of Practice Provisions.

It directly aligns with the RJC Risk Assessment Toolkit and the Human Rights Due Diligence Toolkits.

It can also be used by Auditors conduct the independent audits and supplement the Audit Report.



Overview of Features and Content

- Provisions and questions screened based on:
 - Type of Assessment (Self Assessment, Certification, Mid-Term or Re-certification Audit)
 - Member activities (Mining, Manufacturer, Retail, etc)
 - Materials in the Supply Chain (diamond, gold, PGM)
 - Harmonisation and technical equivalent certifications (e.g. SA8000, ISO14001, OHSAS18001)
 - Provenance Claims
- Tracks completion of questions including number of nonconformances and Not Applicable Provisions
- Corrective Action Template
- Ability to export Monitoring and Evaluation Data
- Statement of Conformance Template
- Content for the Audit Report
