We review and/or audit our suppliers' chain of custody documents. We also integrate blockchain technology and GIA Diamond Origin Report to showcase the journey of select collections of diamonds." 93% of the gold used in Brilliant Earth products is certified recycled by refiners who have been audited and certified to RJC Chain of Custody or SCS Recycled Content. In addition to these certifications held by the refiners, we review and/or audit our suppliers' recycled gold content both internally and through the use of third-party partners. Brilliant Earth recycled diamonds are repurposed from previously-owned jewelry. Recycled diamonds are diamonds that have been returned as part of our lifetime warranty program or are purchased from licensed second-hand dealers and invoices have a post-consumer verification declaration.
