ISGOLD exclusively sources gold bullions from LBMA Good Delivery List refiners, ensuring compliance with the highest standards of responsible sourcing and quality assurance. Additionally, purchasing scrap gold from jewelry factories under RJC standards requires proof that the jewelry factories source their bullions from LBMA-certified refiners. ISGOLD also ensures that these factories adhere strictly to ethical, legal, and traceability requirements. By implementing robust due diligence practices and adhering to the principle of transparency, ISGOLD ensures compliance with international standards while actively contributing to responsible and sustainable sourcing practices.

- A. Mid-term review NOT required due to:**
- No anticipated changes to the certification scope during the certification period

- <25 full time equivalent personnel
- Low risk of non-conformances due to management controls

 - New systems and controls for critical provisions that could not be tested at the certification audit
 - Need to test new systems and controls ensuring respect for critical provisions
 - Facilities with risk of non-conformances with critical provisions
 - Other reasons presented by the lead auditor necessitating an onsite verification
