To the Best of our knowledge and/or written assurance from our suppliers, The Jewelry Company states that diamonds have not been obtained in violation and/or sanctions by the US departments of Treasuries office of foreign assets control (OFAC) and have not originated from the MBADA and Marange resources of Zimbabwe. To the Best of our knowledge and/or written assurance from our suppliers, we state that diamonds have not been sourced from artisanal mines and are in compliance with the relevant WFDB charter. The Jewelry Company has synthetic diamonds testing technology and all the diamonds are checked in the testing machines for the surety of natural diamonds. The Jewelry Company, warrants that the gold, diamonds and silver have been supplied in compliance with the Signet Responsible Sourcing Protocols ("SRSPs").
